Christoph Conrad studied law in Berlin and Göttingen. He completed his legal traineeship in Berlin and Perth/Australia. Christoph Conrad was admitted to the Bar in 1995.

From 1992 to 1995, he was legal advisor for a project corporation engaged in road construction projects as part of the German unity traffic initiatives where he was mainly responsible for supporting official planning approval procedures.

In 1995, he became self-employed as a lawyer. From 1995 to 2002, he collaborated with several partners to build up a cross-regional law firm specialized on construction, architecture and procurement law for which he initially managed the Berlin office before moving on to manage the office in Düsseldorf in 2001/2002.
