Dr. Marc Steffen studied law in Hamburg and Zurich – also completing his doctorate at the University of Hamburg. From 2001 to 2005, he lectured at the University of Hamburg and still lectures today at the Berlin School of Economics and Law. From 2005 onwards, he worked as a lawyer at reputable law firms in Hamburg and Koblenz - with a special focus on construction and architecture law

In January 2009, Dr. Marc Steffen moved on to join Leinemann Partner Rechtsanwälte where he continued to provide advisory and forensic services to the construction and architecture law sector and in the procurement law field. Insolvency law is another of his main areas of focus where he provides advice to globally-operating companies - the interests of which he also represents before the courts. He provides consulting services to large-scale projects, in particular, major infrastructure measures (railway stations and airports), structural engineering projects (high-rise office buildings and shopping center construction and revitalization projects), as well as engineering and hydraulic engineering measures (offshore wind farms).
